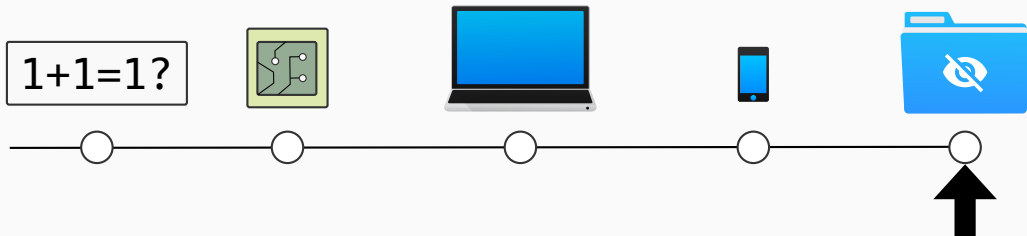

- ... what is privacy?



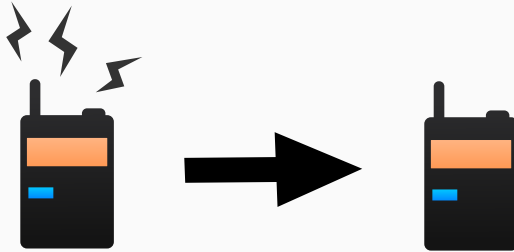
PRIVACY ORIENTED DESIGN

WHAT'S A RADIO? ANONYMOUS BROADCAST COMMUNICATION

- Flood transmitter (broadcast) / one-way receiver
- On a common bandwidth, communication is anonymous
- Like shouting to the void and hoping someone will hear you
- Fun!!



HOW DOES THE INTERNET WORK? AGGRESSIVE HANDSHAKING

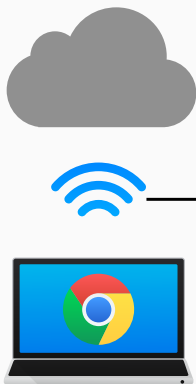

THE GOOD AND THE BAD

GOOD: Private communication with HTTPS connections

BAD: Like giving a copy of:

1. your fingerprints
2. your home address
3. your passport

... to every server you connect to... **ever**.

DATENSPARSEMKEIT

“The default attitude at the moment is that any data you generate is not just freely usable by the capturer but furthermore becomes their valuable commercial property.” — *Martin Fowler*

If you are running a web server you do not have to keep this information.

If you are running a web server you should honour DNT requests.

Example Nginx server block

```
server {  
    listen 80;  
    server_name example.com;  
    return 301 https://$host$request_uri;  
    access_log off;  
}
```

A hopefully unneeded reminder:

→ Make sure your server logic is in a block with properly configured SSL.

USER/HOST POWER DIFFERENTIAL

CAUSING ACCIDENTAL HARM (YIKES!)

- 2014 introduced “Your Year in Review”
- Highlights determined by engagement as main proxy
- Users not considered as real people
- People were shown painful memories in a cheery context 😞

ABUSIVE ANTI-PATTERNS

- ✗ Lying to your users (real trusting people!)
- ✗ Aggressive user profiling and tracking
- ✗ Introducing hidden “anti-features” which do not serve users people
- ✗ Treating users people as a commodity

Freedom is Slavery.

Ignorance is Strength.

Free software today... keeps the Thought Police away!

IF I CAN'T DISRESPECT MY USERS...

HOW DO I MAKE MONEY?

Why is software different than any other industry?

The Short Answer

No...

But:

- Express your creativity and explore technology
- Remember software's use-cases have real-world repercussions
- Hack! Build! Exploit! (don't abuse your findings)
- Try to make the world a better place for everyone 🇨🇳

- DuckDuckGo — The search engine that doesn't track you.
 - Revenue model: advertising and affiliate partnerships
- NextCloud — Self-hostable cloud storage and groupware
 - Revenue model: enterprise support subscriptions
- RedHat Linux — Commercial Linux distribution
 - Revenue model: commercial support and training, cloud integrations
